1. Summary by Leslie Golden
2. Agreed upon by majority of those present at this meeting:
 - a bench or wall will not be installed at the Woodbine corner
 - native planting; plants to be donated by Friends of Sausal Creek
 - planting and maintenance of plants by Fruitvale/Woodbine corner volunteers
 - paving (“river theme”) in muted colors using flagstone on decomposed granite and loose pebbles (salmon bay 3/8”; Mexican red pebbles 1/2-1”) (example: 2111 Woodbine)
 - Boulders (3)
 - Use of Fruitvale Alive! fence will be decided once landscape design is approved
3. Planting and maintenance: Tim Little will email Karen Colaric the “Adopt A Spot” form
4. Next step: Leslie Golden will prepare landscape plans
5. This group has split into two working projects: Fruitvale/Woodbine residents and other interested volunteers will be planting and maintaining the Fruitvale/Woodbine corner; another group will work on a mosaic bench at a location to be decided.
